3 WAYS TO VOTE IN PENNSYLVANIA

Vote by Mail

April 16, 5:00 p.m. Deadline to apply for mail-in ballot

April 23, 8:00 p.m. Deadline for ballot to be received by County Election Board

- No "naked" ballots—use both envelopes!
- Sign and date the outer declaration envelope!
- Use blue or black ink only.

Note: You can be an "Annual Mail Voter" by selecting that option on your mail-in request. A mail-in ballot will automatically be sent to you for the November election.



Vote Early In-Person

April 16, 5:00 p.m. Final deadline for early in-person voting

- Go to the County Board of Elections, City Hall, Room 142. (For office hours and alternate locations, visit vote.pa.gov.)
- Request a mail-in ballot.
- Complete the ballot on the spot and hand it back in.



Vote at the Polls

Tuesday, April 23

Polls are open 7:00 a.m.- 8:00 p.m.
