## 3 WAYS TO VOTE IN PENNSYLVANIA



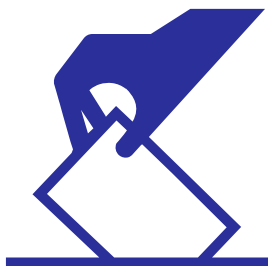
### Vote by Mail

**April 16, 5:00 p.m.**  
Deadline to apply for mail-in ballot

**April 23, 8:00 p.m.**  
Deadline for ballot to be **received** by County Election Board

- No “naked” ballots—**use both envelopes!**
- **Sign** and **date** the outer declaration envelope!
- Use blue or black ink only.

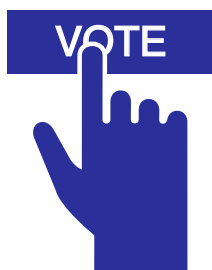
Note: You can be an “Annual Mail Voter” by selecting that option on your mail-in request. A mail-in ballot will automatically be sent to you for the November election.



### Vote Early In-Person

**April 16, 5:00 p.m.**  
Final deadline for early in-person voting

- Go to the County Board of Elections, City Hall, Room 142. (For office hours and alternate locations, visit [vote.pa.gov](http://vote.pa.gov).)
- Request a mail-in ballot.
- Complete the ballot on the spot and hand it back in.

**Tuesday, April 23**  
Polls are open 7:00 a.m.– 8:00 p.m.
