3 WAYS TO VOTE IN PENNSYLVANIA



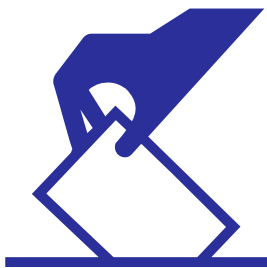
Vote by Mail

Apply until May 13, 5:00 p.m.
Deadline to apply for mail-in ballot

May 20, 8:00 p.m.
Deadline for ballot to be **received**
by County Election Board

- No “naked” ballots—**use both envelopes!**
- **Sign** and **date** the outer declaration envelope!
- Use blue or black ink only.

Note: You can be an “Annual Mail Voter” by selecting that option on your mail-in request. A mail-in ballot will automatically be sent to you for the November election.



Vote Early In-Person

Before May 13, 5:00 p.m.
Final deadline for early in-person voting

- Go to the County Board of Elections, City Hall, Room 142.
(For office hours and alternate locations, visit vote.phila.gov)
- Request a mail-in ballot.
- Complete the ballot on the spot and hand it back in.



Vote at the Polls

On Tuesday, May 20
Polls are open 7:00 a.m.– 8:00 p.m.
