3 WAYS TO VOTE IN PENNSYLVANIA



Vote by Mail

Apply until May 12, 5:00 p.m.
Deadline to apply for mail-in ballot
May 19, 8:00 p.m.
Deadline for ballot to be **received**
by County Election Board

- No “naked” ballots—**use both envelopes!**
- **Sign** and **date** the outer declaration envelope!
- Use blue or black ink only.



Vote Early In-Person

Before May 12, 5:00 p.m.
Final deadline for early in-person voting

- Go to the County Board of Elections, City Hall, Room 142. (For office hours and alternate locations, check vote.phila.gov.)
- Request a mail-in ballot.
- Complete the ballot on the spot and hand it back in.



Vote at the Polls

On Tuesday, May 19
Polls are open 7 a.m. – 8 p.m.

** You have a legal right to cast a provisional ballot at the polling place.*
